One of the major inspirations for the project is the famed photographic series titled "Kamaitchi" by Eikoh Hosoe, who captured the performance photos of the founder of Butoh, Tatsumi Hijikata in the remote village of Tashiro within Akita Japan.











UNBEARABLE DARKNESS REPORT _ RESEARCH IN TASHIRO

Research at The Kamaitchi Museum in Tashiro. The Museum is set up in 2016, 50 years after Tatsumi Hijikata and Eikoh Hosoe had visit the Village. The encounters with the villages who met Hijikata 50 years ago was a vaulable oral histoires recoreded as part of the research archive.

UNBEARABLE DARKNESS REPORT _ TOHOKU FIELD TRIP RESEARCH

The Field-Trip Research provided various visual material for the documentary making process, where we started from Tashiro to Akita to Aomori and finally reach the northen tip of Tohoku at Osorezan. Through the journey, we have discovered many more historical and sub-cultures from the Tohoku Region.











UNBEARABLE DARKNESS REPORT _ TOHOKU FIELD TRIP RESEARCH

Research on After-lives culture at Koboji Temple in Aomori, where there is a collection of about 1000 Japanese Doll for After-Lives marriage. The Earliest doll was dated back to the 1940s











UNBEARABLE DARKNESS REPORT _ TOHOKU FIELD TRIP RESEARCH

Hundreds of abandoned Jizo Status are collected in this temple in Aomori and it has a tradition of Itako gathering to help people to connect to the ghosts of relatives and family member. It holds the same practise as the temple in Osorezan, but it was not commercialize as what Osorezan is today.











UNBEARABLE DARKNESS REPORT _ INTERVIEWING HIJIKATA's SPIRIT

We manage to locate one of the last few practicing Itako (Hiroko Matsuda) who work at Osorezan and visited her home in Hachinohe. We requested session to call for the Spirit of Tatsumi Hijkata. We interview Hijikata on buoth and telling him how Butoh had evloved for the last 30 years. Finally we invited him to collborate on the new performance in 2018

At the end of the Research trip in Tohoku, we travelled to Sapporo to attend the internationl Butoh Festival. This was a great chance to meet and interview Butoh Artist.
